Sentence Pattern 1

Compound sentence: semicolon, no conjunction (two short, related sentences now joined)

S + V ; S + V

E.g. Caesar, try on this toga; it seems to be your size.

E.g. Success has many fathers; failure is an orphan.

E.g. He who knows others is wise; he who knows himself is enlightened.

Sentence Pattern 2

Compound sentence with elliptical construction

S + V + O or SC ; S , O or SC
(omitted verb)

E.g. The Christian church and communism each has a goal: one is spiritual; the other, material.

E.g. Because of the length of both oceans, the Atlantic and the Pacific share the same boundaries; the Arctic, is the northern; the Antarctic, the southern.

E.g. The Russian ballerina wears a tutu; the Malaysian dancer, a brightly colored sarong.

Sentence Pattern 3

Compound sentence with explanatory statement (clauses separated by a colon)

General statement (idea) : **specific statement (example)**

(an independent clause)

(an independent clause)

E.g. Remember Yogi Berra's advice: it ain't over till it's over.

E.g. A lizard never worries about losing his tail: It can always grow another one.

E.g. Weekdays are very similar to identical suitcases: They are all the same size, but some people can pack more into them than others.

A series without a conjunction (a series in any part of a sentence)

A, B, C

E.g. The goals of the ecology-awareness movement are clear: breathable air, drinkable water, livable space, viable soil, portable waterways.

E.g. I have come to you without sin, without guile, without evil, without a witness against me.

E.g. They focus on the bottom line, and through their knowledge make decisions about which projects and products to fund, which to cut, which strategies will work, which will not.
